

Bicycle Plant Marker Tutorial



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Original Machine Embroidery Designs
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Supplies Needed

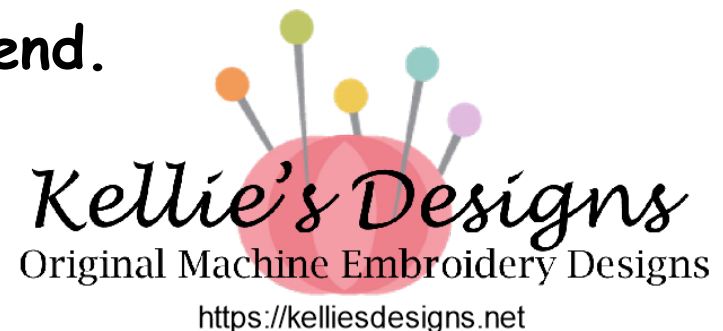
*Regular embroidery supplies, stabilizer, thread, scissors etc. (Note: I like cutaway stabilizer for most ITH projects unless otherwise indicated. I find that it provides more stability to the finished product.

*Vinyl or cork. Felt would also work if you used a heavy duty stabilizer.

* $\frac{3}{4}$ inch craft stick

*double sided tape

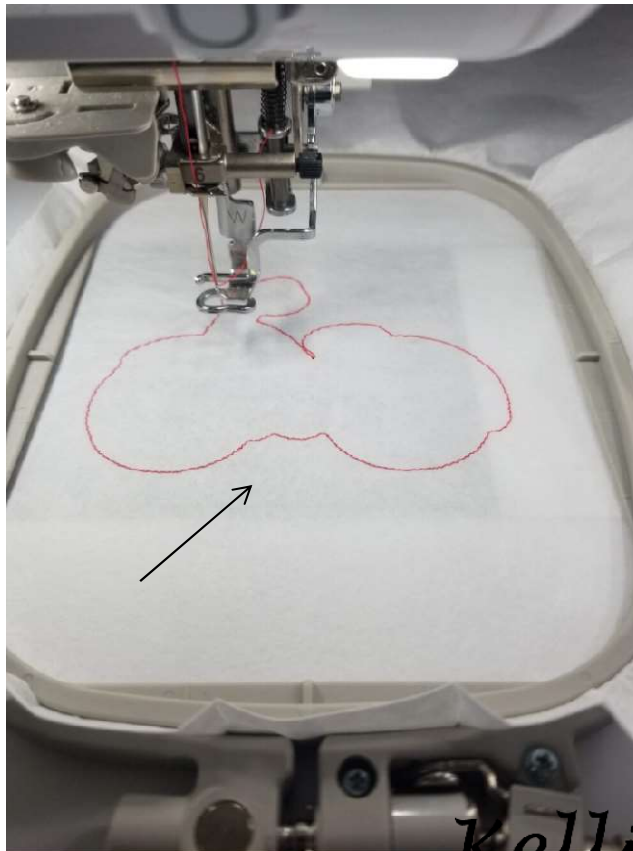
***My supplies are listed at the end.**



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Color Change 1: Placement stitch - stitch directly on stabilizer.

Cover with vinyl or cork.



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Color change 2: Stitches bike frame



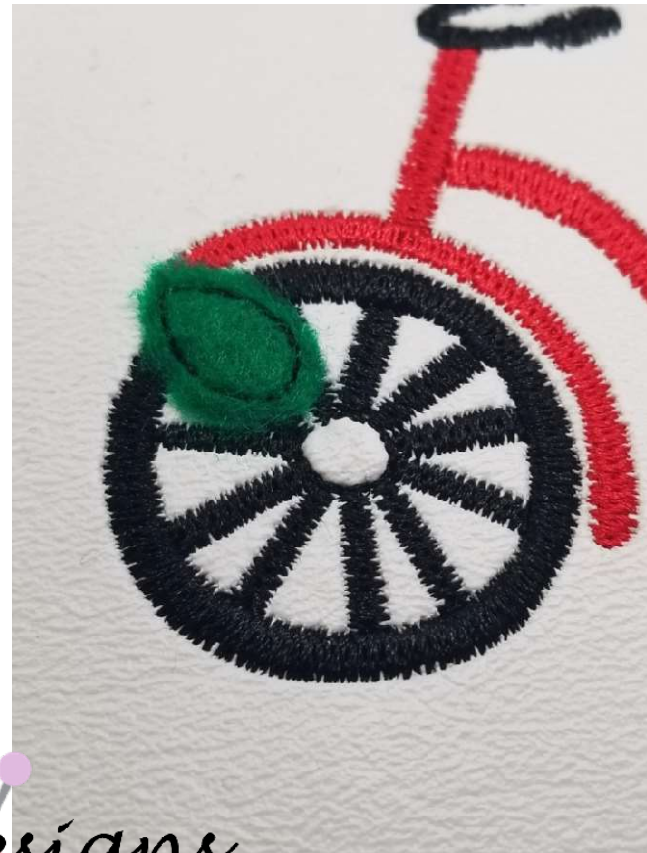
Color change 3: Stitches tires, seat and handle bars



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Color Change 4: Placement line
for leaf, cover with felt or vinyl

Color Change 5: Tack down
for leaf, trim



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Color Change 6: Placement
line for flower



Color Change 7: Tack down
for flower, trim



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Color Change 8: Placement line for flower center



Color Change 9: Tack down for flower center, trim



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Color Change 10: Placement line for leaf



Color Change 11: Tack down for leaf, trim



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Color Change 12: Placement line for flower



Color Change 13: Tack down for flower, trim



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Color Change 14: Placement line for flower center



Color Change 15: Tack down for flower center, trim



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Color Change 16: Design outline



Color Change 17: Place backing under hoop and run final bean stitch creating pocket for craft stick



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Bicycle Plant Marker - Pro tip!

Carefully cut out your design and insert your craft stick.
Lightly mark with a pencil however deep you want the stick.
Pull the stick back out and put double sided tape on the stick and reinsert into the design. Press firmly on the back of the design so that the tape holds the stick in place.

That's it! You're done!

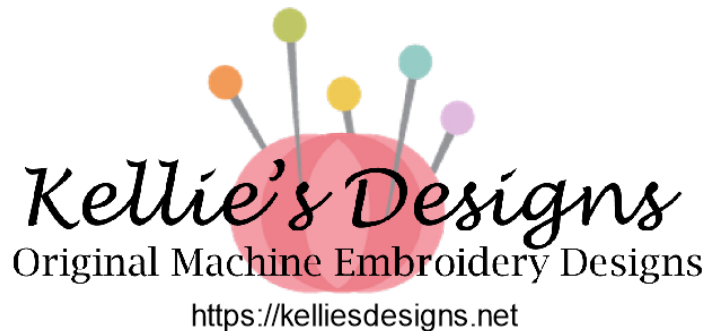
