

Supplies Needed

*Regular embroidery supplies, stabilizer, thread, scissors etc. (Note: I like cutaway stabilizer for most ITH projects unless otherwise indicated. I find that it provides more stability to the finished product.

*Vinyl or cork for front and back

*Oly fun (or something similar) for the lining so you can't see the threads inside the card holder.

FRONT

BACK - by doing it this way, your stitching will be hidden.



Original Machine Embroidery Designs

Color Change 13: Place backing under hoop and run final bean stitch

The final bean stitch goes around 3 sides of the card holder leaving the top open so you can slide in the card.



Original Machine Embroidery Designs

Teacher Thanks Gift Card Holder - Pro tip!

When your cutting out the card holder - cut straight across the top and then go back and open the holder and cut around the curve. The backside will remain straight.

That's it! You're done!


